The Baku-Tblisi-Ceyhan pipeline transports crude 1,760 km (1,094 miles) from the Azeri-Chirag-Guneshli oil field in the Caspian Sea to the Mediterranean Sea.

It passes through Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan; Tblisi, the capital of Georgia; and Ceyhan, a port on the south-eastern Mediterranean coast of Turkey, hence its name.

It is the second longest oil pipeline in the world and one of the biggest engineering projects of the decade.
